# FROM THE CLASSROOMS

#### Music – Mrs. Wright

We are getting very excited to share the musical "We 3 Spies" with you next Tuesday, Lord willing! The students have been working hard at learning all the songs and actions. Our composers of the month are Christy and Daniel Semson the creators of "We 3 Spies." The students were excited to hear a bit about their lives and I was excited to share that Christy Semsen responded to my email asking for their bio and photo for our "Composer of the Month" display in the classroom.

The JK and SK classes have been enjoying singing and playing tambourines with the song "There Was a Little Baby." The students have been working on a rest-play-rest-play pattern.

#### Junior Kindergarten – Mrs. Baarda

We are still getting ready for Christmas in JK! Last week we talked about how a candy cane can help us remember that J is for Jesus, red reminds us about the blood shed for us on the cross, white reminds us that Jesus was without sin, and the staff reminds us that Jesus is our Shepherd and takes care of us. This week we continue in our Christmas theme and our Christmas art activities and songs.

This week our focus letter is Jj. Students are welcome to bring in a show and tell item that begins with J. We will continue to work in our *Handwriting Without Tears* book. Students have made progress already with their pencil control!

In math, we will continue to recognize patterns, and to make patterns using different objects.

In Bible, we will focus on the birth of Jesus! We are practicing our new verse for the Christmas program as well as our songs.

For the Christmas program children should wear their Sunday best. We will meet in our classroom before the evening performance. In the afternoon we will head back to our classroom after our part of the performance. In the evening, children will sit with their parents after our part of the performance and can enjoy the rest of the program with you.

#### Senior Kindergarten – Mrs. Heida

This week we will be focusing more closely on the letter Ss, the sound it makes and where we hear it in the pictures we will see. Please send your student in with a show and tell item that either begins or ends with "S" and the students will decide where they hear the letter "s" sound.

Students will also be introduced to syllables, how many parts each word has. Ask your child to "clap out" their name. Our new sight word is "we" this week. Please send in all reading logs on Friday. Continue to review the other sight words we have learned over the past several weeks.

In math, we are working with five and ten frames and continuing to print numbers to 13.

In Bible, we will hear from Simeon and Anna as well as the Wise Men. The students are singing their Christmas songs to the fullest and reciting their verse for the Christmas Program with enthusiasm!

In our classroom, we will continue working on Christmas crafts and Christmas baking.
