## PRINCIPAL'S CORNER

I have never been a big fan of new year's resolutions. Over the Christmas break we had the opportunity to be with my sister-in-law who, for the last nine months, has been courageously fighting bone cancer. After radiation, chemo, and two stem cell transplants, she is currently doing well. She is in good spirits and her testimony is powerful. She attributes her courage and ability to endure this hardship to her faith and to the support of her friends in Christ.

January, a time of reflection, encourages me to appreciate the power of faith and the unity of the Christian community. We have witnessed this within our own Listowel community over the past year as well. #### Music – Mrs. Wright

#### Junior Kindergarten – Mrs. Baarda

Happy New Year! I want to thank all of you for the cards, gifts and Christmas wishes. I had a great holiday and hope that you all did as well.

Now back into school routine! This month we will have a winter theme.

This week we will do mitten themed art and will make a snowstorm in a jar.

This week our focus letter is L. Children may bring in an item that begins with the letter L for show and tell on either Tuesday or Thursday.

We will work in our *Handwriting Without Tears* workbook. We have begun printing letters! Also, we will be practicing printing our names in different ways.

In math, we will review what we know about patterns, and build patterns together.

In Bible, we begin a new unit. Our first lessons are about Jonah. New memory work is Hebrews 13:5b-6a "God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you." So we say with confidence "The Lord is my Helper; I will not be afraid."

### Senior Kindergarten – Mrs. Heida

Welcome back! I hope that everyone had a good holiday and are ready for routine and learning! This week our focus letter is Dd, both as a beginning and ending sound. We will review rhyming, and will be introduced to how the alphabet works, and to syllables. Our new sight word this week is "in", please return book bags on Friday for the last of the pre-decodable books!

I will be doing some assessment on sight words to see how well the students recognize the sight words in various places such as on their own and in a sentence.

In math, we will review how to print teen numbers and how to use the 10-frame. Students will also be introduced to AB and AAB patterns.

In Bible, we will begin our unit about Moses. Memory work is Exodus 15:2- "The Lord is my strength and my song. He has become my salvation. He is my God, and I will praise Him, my Father's God, and I will exalt Him." For phys ed, we will be working on balancing activities on Mondays in the gym and Fridays we will continue to work on our skating skills. I was very impressed with each student's determination as they skated before Christmas. It was great to see them encouraging each other. **Please remember helmets, snow pants, mittens/gloves and skates on Friday.**
