Junior Kindergarten – Mrs. Baarda

What a great first week! I was very impressed with all of the new JK students, they all did so well on their first day of school. I am excited to now join together as a whole class.

This week we will begin our regular schedule. This means that we will have Library and Music on Tuesday. Students will choose a book to bring home for one week from the Library, to be returned next week. Mrs. Wright will meet the students and teach them for their first music class. We will have our first Phys. Ed. class on Thursday as well as begin *Reading Buddies* with the Grade 3/4 class.

In math we will learn to recognize things that are the same and different.

In language we will practice recognizing the first letters of our names.

In **Bible** we begin our unit on *Creation*. Our first memory work is Genesis 1:1 "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." We will work on this together in class but I would encourage you to practice at home as well.

In **health** we begin our first unit where we will learn that we are each created unique. We will look at our fingerprints to see how they are all different!

Spelling- our spelling program will begin next week.

We are beginning our first unit/topic in each subject. Here are some ways to help your child at home: Practice printing upper case and lower case letters, explore ways to sort objects (colour, size, shape etc.) and read books together.

A weekly homework sheet will be sent home starting next week.

Grade 2 and 3 – Mrs. Claus

SMARTBOARD!!! - Our class is very blessed to have a Smartboard! We use the Smartboard every day for various activities. Almost all lessons are done on the Smartboard and lesson slides can be sent as PDF files to parents. It is a great way for you to see what we have done in class and what students will need to study for quizzes and tests. If students are absent, notes can also be emailed to help students complete any missing work. If you would like me to send the Smartboard notes to you after every unit, please e-mail me and let me know you are interested, and I will send them to you through e-mail.

Memory Work - "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law." Students need to know our theme verse (Galatians 5:22-23) for FRIDAY. Starting next week, we will be working on memorizing the books of the Old Testament.

Spelling - We are starting Unit 1 words this week and will have dictation on FRIDAY. The Spelling lists (for the whole year) are on the Spelling City website. If you go to spellingcity.com and search "Delleman" my name will

come up with "Listowel Christian School" next to it. When you click on "Mrs. Delleman" a list of all the units will open up. Grade 3 and 4 lists are all on there. When you click on the list name, the words appear as well as a button called "Games" where students can play a number of activities with their spelling words. I will be showing the website to students this week as well. We work on spelling words throughout the week and play games on the Smartboard to review every Friday. If you have trouble with the website or can't find a list, please email and let me know. **Cursive** - We started last week already with letters "a" and "d". The cursive pages for these letters are due on FRIDAY. Students work on these letters throughout the week, but any work that is incomplete needs to be done for homework and returned every Friday. GRADE 3 pages are 5, 6, 28 (JUST letters "a" and "d") and GRADE 4 pages are 4, 12 (just the bottom two lines with lowercase "a" and "d").

Grade 5 and 6 – Mrs. Vogel

French: We are working on review and learning some verb conjugations.

Grade 5 and 6 – Mr. Katerberg

Our class had a good start to the school year with lots of introductions to the range of subjects and expectations for the school year. This week we will complete the introductory material. There are several things that may need to be completed at home this week.

Bible: Our Bible unit is The Setting of God's Story.

Memory work is Colossians 3: 12 - 14, this is due on Friday. "Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity."

Word Work: Lesson 1 quiz on Friday.

Science: Students have been given an assignment that asks them to go stargazing with a parent on a clear evening. Please take some time in the next week or so (weather permitting) to complete this assignment. **Math:** Students may have daily math homework. As a rule, no more than 30 minutes should be required to complete this.

Students have been signed onto **Google classroom** at school. They should also be able to work from home. On Friday, they were given a very short assignment to check and see they can log in from home. We will be using Google classroom for several of our subjects and assignments.

Grade 7 and 8 – Ms. tenBrink

Bible: To start off this year, we are looking at the how the Bible is one Story. This week any handouts (the Names of God and crossword), are due and are to be handed in by Friday. Don't forget to put your name and date that it was given at the top of the page. Remember to use the hand in bin in the classroom.

Memory work for this week will be Deuteronomy 6:4-6. Students should be ready to say or write it next week Wednesday, September 18.

Grade 7 and 8 – Mrs. Vogel
