Our typical teaching day is very busy and the only time we have to talk about these topics are informal discussions while walking down the hallway or a brief time at lunch or outside on yard duty with a colleague. Having a whole day to invest and immerse ourselves into one topic was extremely valuable and our staff have the relationships to openly challenge and share with each other. What a great day.
